To design the headquarters of a new local bank that maximized the site by providing the required parking to match the F.A.R.

The client asked for a dual nature to be expressed in the buildings design. The bank was to be seen as solid in nature, yet to be open and accessible at the same time.

A curved glass curtain wall was used to embrace the intersection of the two main streets.

The sweeping canopies were used to draw the pedestrian inside of the building.

The dual nature of the building is expressed by the use of the curtain wall and a pre-cast panel system.
